Tamsui, 1865. After becoming a treaty port following the Tianjin Accords of 1858, Tamsui is flooded with ambitious entrepreneurs. After studying the climate of Taiwan, the Scotsman John Dodd is optimistic about the future development of the tea industry in Taiwan. He sets up a firm in preparation of growing and exporting tea. Around the same time, Li Chun-Sheng arrives from Xiamen. His proficiency in English allows Chun-Sheng to become Dodd's assistant, but they find themselves facing disinterested local tea farmers, obstinate government officials, cheating business partners, among many other difficulties. Despite the odds, they manage to struggle on and make real names for themselves in the history of the tea industry in Taiwan.

While *A Teatime Adventure* tells a simple story, Kiya Chang's skillful use of dialogue and characterization makes this story about the distant past not only informative, but also interesting and engaging for contemporary readers.

About the Author

Born in 1988, **Kiya Chang** is the daughter of a Chiayi tea farmer. To realize her goal of becoming a professional comic artist, she changed schools to the Fu-Hsin Trade and Arts School in Taipei. But not until 2007 was she finally given the opportunity to have her work serialized in a monthly magazine, with the baseball comic *Take Me Out to the Ball Park*. Eager to learn more about tea in Taiwan, she started to draw comics on the subject. Aside from this book and its sequel, she has also written and illustrated *The Tea Farmer's Almanac*, providing fun facts and anecdotes about tea. In 2015, she was chosen to represent Taiwan at the Angoulême International Comics Festival and the Frankfurt Book Fair.

After the 1999 Jiji earthquake devastated Nantou, Taiwan, demons broke free to wreak havoc in the terrestrial realm, causing the police to set up "Project Blackout" to eliminate them. One day, a terrible monster appears in the popular Ximending neighborhood of Taipei. The police team up with gifted teenage magician Chen Po-Jung to behead the beast and banish the evil spirit. During the fight, Po-Jung encounters what appears to be a high school aged girl who shares a name with the Goddess Matsu, worshipped by millions in the temples of Taiwan. Po-Jung takes the pretty Matsu under his wing only to discover that

the unrest in the underworld and Matsu's sudden appearance have a surprising hidden connection. . . .

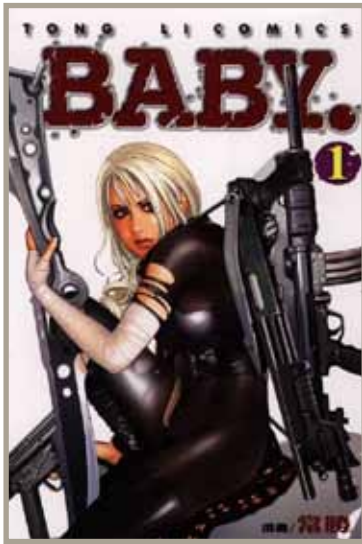
Unlike the majority of long-form comics in Taiwan, which are usually first serialized in magazines before being collected into books, *Record of the Dark Wars* represents a rare exception to the rule. It is also one of the first series to put out more than five volumes. In support of this popular series, the publisher entered into a partnership with the Ximen Street Pedestrian Mall Development Committee to adopt Matsu as the mascot of Ximen Street. Additionally, the Japanese e-book publisher Renta! is currently publishing a Japanese translation online, making it the first Taiwanese comic to be published electronically in Japan.

About the Author

Wei Zhon-Cheng first became known in 2009, when he published the satirical comic *The Coming of Emperor Ma*. Using the Hong Kong-style to parody the competition between then current president Chen Shui-Bian and contender Ma Ying-Jeou, this comic not only attracted the attention of the media, but his spoofing of current events also drew praise from a large audience of readers, making it the number one bestselling comic for that year. It proved so popular that it had to be reprinted ten times. He has since gone on to publish *ROC Armed Forces: Warriors for a New Century*, a satire of the Taiwanese military, and *Romance of the Five Kingdoms and Romance of the Six Kingdoms*, which use cute personifications of Taiwan's provinces and cities to mock the electoral system.

In both his satirical comics and the ongoing *Record of the Dark Wars*, Zhong-Cheng mixes Hong Kong and Japanese manga styles. His work also contains meticulous

research. He believes that if Taiwanese comics are going to develop and flourish, they must first attract the attention of local audiences. He has also managed the social media website Comic Madness (<http://www.weicomic.com/>) for the last 15 years.

December 1, 2043 AD. The mysterious lifeform BABY invades Earth and takes control of a number of human hosts, parasitizing them. The possessed bodies then metamorphize into monsters called "Organos," which slaughter a great mass of humanity in a series of bloody massacres, bringing mankind to the brink of extinction. Thereafter, December 1 comes to be known as "Extinction Day." While battling an Organo, Elisha, the protagonist of the story, finds that her left hand has been infected by BABY. However, aside from a throbbing pain in her hand, nothing about the rest of her body changes. Elisha begins to search for other survivors, hoping to solve the mystery of BABY . . .

BABY was first serialized in a shonen manga magazine before being collected into a five-volume set. It is a rare example of a Taiwanese science fiction comic, and is also considered Chang-Sheng's best known work. Although

he began drawing comics later than many other artists, his bold, outside-the-box thinking has placed him in a league of his own.

About the Author

Chang-Sheng worked in advertising for 15 years. He started his own studio when he was in his thirties and since 2004, he has released work on a regular basis. Having read comics from a young age, Chang-Sheng has always preferred science fiction stories best. He admits to having been deeply influenced by the work of Yukinobu Hoshino, and his training in drawing and oil painting while studying at the Fu-Hsin Trade and Arts School are likewise reflected in his exquisitely detailed and extremely realistic video game-like style. Chang-Sheng has represented Taiwan at the Angoulême International Comics Festival three times. Another of his books, the fantasy *Oldman*, was a finalist for the 2013 International Manga Award in Japan.

Scrolls of a Northern City is set in the Taipei of 1935. The Great Taiwan Exhibition is about to open, and the newly founded city shines as if in a dream, sparkling brightly in the night. In the northernmost corner of the city, on the first floor of Café Bai-Hua-Tang (“Hall of a Hundred Paintings”), the scent of freshly baked pastries wafts on the air, and pretty waitresses wearing kimonos and frilled aprons attend to the customers. On the second floor is the owner’s private library, containing a large and diverse collection of books. Spirits roam the shelves, reading at their leisure. Even more surprising perhaps is that the handsome young owner appears to be hiding a secret power, only to be revealed when things start to go wrong . . .

This book is made up of three short stories, each incorporating elements of fantasy. AKRU depicts the story of a mysterious and magical shopkeeper, who is a medium for the

spirits. She does so with careful brushstrokes, instilling both the historical background and the sentiments of the characters with a dreamlike romance.

About the Author

AKRU started reading manga at a young age. In university, she majored in anthropology, while also teaching herself how to color and scan line work on the side. Her 2007 debut, *The Underwater Moon*, was an adaptation of a traditional folk story; it won several awards and made her a recognized comic artist.

Despite the incredible success of *Scrolls of a Northern City*, with the sequel topping the bestseller charts for three weeks, AKRU does not plan to give up self-publishing her original works in doujinshi. She feels this gives her a greater degree of creative freedom, and she views the work as a way to maintain a dialogue with her readers.

When he was a young boy, manga artist Isamu Kurosawa emerged from the ocean—a gift for what his father had lost. Decades earlier, when his father, Taiwanese fisherman Hsieh Lang-Hsiung, also known as Rou, was no more than a boy himself, he was out fishing with his father, grandfather, and elder brother when their boat got caught in a terrible storm. The male members of his family—father, brother, and grandfather—were all swept overboard by the waves and gale-force winds. When Rou’s brother fell overboard, a terrified Rou fired the harpoon in his direction, hoping to save at least one member of his family. Instead, the harpoon pierced his brother’s body. When he got home, he could only watch as his mother crumpled under the weight of the disaster.

One day, a grown Rou finds a young boy set adrift in a boat, a cloth painted with the name “Kurosawa” tied around his ankle. Rou names him Isamu. Although Isamu Kurosawa’s name and ambiguous heritage made his childhood difficult,

the care and support of his parents gives him the strength to travel to Japan to fulfill his dream of becoming a manga artist. In the memories of his troubled past, Isamu searches for the strength to face reality, and to tell his father’s story.

This beautiful masterpiece of ink-on-paper brings new possibilities for the manga genre, both as narrative and as visual art. Chen Jian’s characters do not “look” like traditional manga characters so often do. Rather, the characters’ faces and bodies reflect their emotions and environments—not the tropes of some cartoon hyperbole. This narrative art speaks in a register that most of us have never heard before.

About the Author

Chen Jian is a comic artist who currently lives in Japan. *Son of the Sea*, his first full-length manga, won the inaugural Tottori Manga Kingdom Contest in 2012 in a complete sweep of the judges’ table. In 2015, he expanded *Son of the Sea* into a full-length book and published it in Taiwan.

This special cooperation came about as a result of New Zealand's Guest of Honor participation in the 2015 Taipei International Book Fair, where this graphic creation activity was proposed. Six graphic novelists traveled to and visited each other's island, first visiting Auckland in October of 2014, and then Taipei in February of 2015.

The visits were not long and communication was a challenge, but nothing proved too difficult for the six of them. With the help of hand gestures, phones, and computers, they shared with each other their works and projects. They revealed their interests, memories, stories, and creations through pen and paper. They guided each other through the pace of life in their cities, embarking on an amusing journey.

This book is based on the legends of assassins from the "Chronicles of the Historian" from the Han dynasty scholar Sima Qian. It includes the legends of the five assassins: Chaomu, Yurang, Juanju, Niezheng and Jingke, during the Spring and Autumn Period and the Warring States Period. The stories are presented in the following order, "Chaomu" abducting Duke Huan of Qi and forcing him to return seized land of the Lu state; "Juanju" assassinating King Liao for

Prince Guang of the Wu State; "Yurang" exacting revenge on Zhao Xiangzi for Zhi Bo out of gratitude; "Niezheng" accepting a request from Yan Sui and assassinating Han Xiaolei; and "Jingke" being commanded by Yan Prince Dan to assassinate King Zheng of Qin.

Chen Uen powerfully recreated the tragedies of the original works, using ink to adapt the narration of Sima Qian, allowing these stories to resonate with the new generation. The colorful vigor of these images all capture the assassins who are about to bring about chaos and turmoil. During an interview, Chen Uen once stated that "Perseverance and Justice" are characteristics of heroes. They follow through with their beliefs. However, because of the obligations of the era, these "loyalty" in these stories and characters differ from our modern ideal of "loyalty". However, Chen Uen insists on drawing these historical figures because of their beliefs. They may lose their life, reputation, but they will still commit the deed. Therefore, Chen Uen regards them all as heroes.

Chen Yuen said, "The assassin with the most controversial design is was Yurang's androgynous appearance. In the beginning, I wanted to express the sacrifice and courage of Yurang

destroying his face. The dog-killing Niezheng is often thought of as an obese butcher. I redesigned him into a warrior to draw out his powerlessness as he hides himself in the marketplace. The collapsing mountains and crumbling land from Chaomu's appearance was a fictitious effect used to emphasize his dramatic arrival. In the assassinations, I did not particularly choose to exclude passion or martial arts; I wanted to utilize the austere atmosphere to heighten the heroic yet tragic mindset of the characters. Regardless of the reason, if the readers are interested in reading the original "Chronicles of the Historian", it will be sure to give the story another layer of appeal."

This book won the award for the best comic from the National Institute for Translation in 1986. It was also published twice: the first edition was published in 1985 by China Times Publishing Co., and second edition was published in 2010 by Dala Publishing Company. In 2017, Dala Publishing designed a collector's edition of "Legends of Assassins" and adapted this classic work into a full color, 18x26 cm hardcover book. Every panel of this comic is a work of art.

The 23rd day of the third lunar month, is said to be the birthday of Mazu. During this time, Mazu Temples all over the world begin preparing for a series of celebratory events, the "Mazu Pilgrimage", which have become the three grand international religious events. This celebration is unusually lively and performances have evolved from simple drum and lion dances in the beginning of the Republic to the deity puppet teams, orchestra performances, and electrical light parades held today, in an effort to make the celebration seem like a rich and grand festival. are crowded with believers of Mazu. These events add a festive atmosphere to incense offerings and pilgrimages.

The novel yet classic Mazu drawings by Chiyou are important elements for welcoming Mazu temple activities, on-site observations, and Mazu beliefs, all of which are deftly represented in the image. The modern Qianliyan, General

Shunfeng'er, Tudigong, Dragon King of the Four Seas, Birth Registry Matron, Nezha, Eight Immortals, and other familiar folk gods all come to life on paper. Most remarkable is that besides the traditional symbols of fortune, many endemic species of Taiwan have all become visual highlights of Mazu clothing. This is indeed of work of perfection!

At the same time, branches of Mazu Temples start to go back to the head temple for offering incense, offering birthday congratulations, and joining the holy pilgrimage. Taiwan's believers are very enthusiastic during this period and the Minnan saying, "Crazy March with Mazu, " is right the best expression to describe the Mazu fanaticism in Taiwan. Variations of celebrating events are extraordinarily bustling as a carnival.
